In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Palashipara PS Case No.502/2025 dated 05.10.2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109/351(2)/352/3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary, the fact that there are case and counter case, that injuries were suffered on both sides and the fact that none of the injuries found in the injury reports was grievous in nature, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioners.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses or

tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever and the petitioners shall meet the Investigating Officer once a week till submission of report in final form.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
