CRM (M) 2259 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kashipur Police Station Case No. 277 of 2023 dated 16.06.2023 under Sections 148/149/341/302/120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section 9B of the Explosives Act, 1884 and Section 3 of the Explosives Substances act, 1908.

Petitioner is in custody for one year four months. The investigation of the case has been concluded and charge-sheet has been submitted. It has been further pointed out that the petitioner's bail were earlier rejected only on the ground that the petitioner was absconding and other accused persons whose complicity on the face of materials on record are much more glaring have been granted bail under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Learned advocate appearing for the State has submitted that petitioner is thickly connected with the alleged offence, it is not only that the investigation has been concluded but charges have already been framed. Additionally it has been

submitted that the petitioner is a history-sheeter against whom four criminal cases are pending.

Having regard to the stage of the case, the complicity of the present petitioner and the fact that the petitioner had been evading the process of law at the initial stage of the case which has jeopardize the investigation, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2259 of 2025 is dismissed.
