C.R.M. (NDPS) 1422 of 2025

In Re: An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Kaliachak Police Station Case No.98 of 2025 dated 23.01.2025 under Section 21(C)/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, and Sections 111(2)(b)/113(3)/61(2)/121(1)/132/109 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023;

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that there has been no recovery from the present petitioner and he has been implicated in connection with the instant case on the basis of the statement of a co-accused.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are criminal antecedents of the present petitioner.

Be that as it may, since the petitioner has been implicated and is detained in custody for the last 52 days only on the basis of the statement of a co-accused, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner namely, Pijush Mandal shall be released on

bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court, (under NDPS Act), Malda. If on bail, the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of Kaliachak Police Station without informing the learned trial court. Petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned trial court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1422 of 2025 is allowed.
