The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of the execution application being Misc. Ex. 4 of 2023 (renumbered as Misc. Ex (Com) 21/2024) pending before the court of the learned Commercial Court at Rajarhat, North 24 Parganas.

The prayer of the petitioner is innocuous. Neither party stands to lose if a proceeding is disposed of expeditiously. In fact, such expeditious disposal shall enure to the benefit of the parties. Hence, there is no requirement for service of prior notice upon the opposite party.

The revisional application is disposed of with a request to the learned court to dispose of the said Misc. Case within two months from the next date fixed. Adequate opportunity shall be granted to the parties to contest the same.

This court has not expressed any opinion either on the maintainability of the Misc. Case or on its

merits. The learned court shall proceed independently and in accordance with law.

A copy of the revisional application along with a server copy of this order be served upon the opposite party and/or the learned advocate contesting the matter on behalf of the opposite party in the learned trial court, within a week.

The revisional application is accordingly disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Parties are to act on the server copy of this order.
