Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

The prosecution case is that the petitioners took money from the de facto complainant for getting his son a job. They kept on communicating including through WhatsApp messages by stating that the work was in progress.

Considering the above and the other materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
