CRM (M) 2318 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **SC No. 416/2025 arising out of Narayanpur PS Case No. 112 of 2025 dt. 09.05.2025 under sections 25(1)(a)/25(1B)(a)/35 of the Arms Act read with Sections 318(2)/318(4)/336(3)/340(2)61(2)/111 of BNS, 2023 & 14C of Foreigners Act.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is similarly situated as the other accused persons who have been granted bail in CRM (M) 2062 of 2025; CRM (M) 2121 of 2025 and CRM (M) 1201 of 2025.

Learned advocate for the State is not in a position to rebut such contention.

Having considered that the petitioner is entitled to have the same privilege as the other accused persons who have been granted bail, I am inclined to enlarge him on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Md. Ziauddin Mondal @ Jia shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two

sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Barrackpore.

If on bail, the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of Narayanpur Police Station without the permission of the Officer-in-charge/Inspector-in-charge of the said police station. The petitioner shall also be physically present on each and every date of the trial so fixed by the learned court *in seisin* of the case.

In case, there is any violation of the aforesaid conditions, the learned court *in seisin* of the case would be at liberty to cancel the bail without further reference to this court.

Accordingly, CRM(M) 2318 of 2025 is **allowed**.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
