1. Heard the learned counsels for the parties.
2. Perused the case diary.
3. It is the petitioner's case that as per the FIR as the petitioner filed an eviction suit against the alleged victim, he consumed poison and committed suicide.
4. It will for the Court to finally decide whether there is any element of abetment of suicide in this case.
5. However, considering the materials available in the case diary, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
6. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local,

to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to further conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and shall not threaten or intimidate the witnesses. The petitioner shall meet the I.O once a fortnight till submission of report in final form.

7. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
