C.R.M. (NDPS) 1445 of 2025

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Tehatta Police Station Case No. 57 of 2024 dated 25.01.2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the subject-matter of the case relates to 29 bottles of phensedyl having been recovered, although the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused in connection with the instant case. It has further been submitted that investigation has been concluded and charge-sheet has been submitted before the jurisdictional court.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered the subject-matter of the case and the period of detention of the present petitioner and the fact that investigation of the case has already been concluded, I am of the opinion that further detention of the present

petitioner is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Sariful Sk @ Sariful Mondal** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court under the NDPS Act, Krishnagar, Nadia.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Nadia without the leave of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1445 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
