Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody for 2 years and 9 months and
only 4 witnesses have been examined out of the proposed 25
witnesses. Attention of the Court is drawn to the order dated
16.04.2025 which reflects that the present petitioner was
involved in trafficking of the victim to Delhi for sexual
exploitation.

Learned advocate for the State seek some more time to
complete the examination of witnesses and submits that 4
more witnesses are to be examined by the prosecution.
Prosecution would complete the 4 witnesses proposed to be
examined preferably by 31.03.2026.

No unnecessary adjournment be granted to any of the parties. The trial of the case would continue in spite of any resolution by the local bar.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2369 of 2025 is dismissed at this stage.
