CRM (NDPS) 1467 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Manikchak Police Station Case No. 680 of 2025 dated 30.08.2025 under Sections 21(c)/27(A)/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated in connection with the instant case on the basis of statement of co-accused and the subject matter of the case relates to recovery of 15 bottles of phensedyl. Petitioner is in custody for a period of 79 days.

Learned advocate appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail. However, State is not in a position to rebut the factum that there has been no seizure from the possession of the present petitioner.

Taking the same into account, I am of the view that further detention of the petitioner is unwarranted. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

As such the petitioner namely, **Mahadeb Mandal** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act cum Additional Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Malda.

If on bail, the petitioner shall meet with the Investigating Officer of the case once in a week till the charge-sheet is submitted before the jurisdictional Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1467 of 2025 is **allowed**.
