The petitioners pray for expeditious disposal of Misc. Case No.29 of 2025 along with a pending interlocutory application in connection with Civil Execution Case No. 11 of 2018, arising out of O.C. Suit No. 161 of 1999, pending before the learned Civil Judge(Junior Division), Islampur, Uttar Dinajpur.

The prayer of the petitioners is innocuous. Neither party stands to lose if a proceeding is disposed of expeditiously. In fact, such expeditious disposal shall enure to the benefit of the parties. Hence, there is no requirement for service of prior notice upon the opposite parties.

The revisional application is disposed of with a request to the learned court to dispose of the said application as also the Misc. Case No. 29 of 2025 within four months from the next date fixed. Adequate opportunity shall be granted to the parties to contest the same.

This court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the application and the misc. case. The learned court shall proceed independently and in accordance with law.

A copy of the revisional application along with a server copy of this order be served upon the opposite parties and/or the learned advocate contesting the matter on behalf of the opposite parties in the learned trial court, within a week.

The revisional application is accordingly disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Parties are to act on the server copy of this order.
