An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Daspur P.S. Case No.334 of 2022 dated 10.08.2022 under Sections 448/435/436/34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is a second application for anticipatory bail. The first one was rejected by a Division Bench of this Court on 12.10.2022 in CRM(A) 4875 of 2022. Now, there is a change in circumstance inasmuch as a charge-sheet has been submitted.

Learned counsel for the State submits that a charge-sheet has been submitted under the same provisions as were contained in the FIR. Therefore, there is no material change in circumstance.

Submission of charge-sheet is a natural consequence in criminal law after filing of the FIR.

It appears that a charge-sheet has been submitted in this case over the same provisions that were contained in the FIR.

Therefore, there is no material or substantial change in circumstance so as to entertain the second application for anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is rejected.
