In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Suti Police Station Case No. 990 of 2024 dated 27.12.2024 registered for investigation into offences punishable under Sections 21(b)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for about 11 (eleven) months and the subject matter of the case relates to alleged recovery of 96 bottles of Phensedyl from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner prays for bail on any condition as there is possibility of trial to be concluded in the near future.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the period of retention of the present petitioner and of the view that further retention is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Bikal Sk** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge Special Court under the NDPS Act cum Additional Sessions Judge, 5th Court at Berhampore, Murshidabad.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Murshidabad without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1475 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
