In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Indian Penal Code/Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Purba Jadavpur** P.S. Case No. **22 of 2025** dated **21.04.2025** under Sections **498A/ 406/ 494/ 307/ 506/ 34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits as follows. The petitioner is the husband of the alleged victim. The other in-laws were granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court. The marriage between the couple took place nine years ago.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. She relies on the statements of witnesses. She submits that the petitioner did not comply with the notices issued. However, there is no injury report available in the case diary.

Considering the above and the other materials available in the case diary, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant to anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with investigation, shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses and shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight till submission of report in final form.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
