CRM (NDPS) 1492 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Balurghat PS Case No. 459 of 2025 dated 12.07.2025 u/s 21(c)/22(c)/23(c)/25/27A/29 of the NDPS Act (corresponding to NDPS Case No. 44 of 2025).**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 116 days and there were recoveries.

However, the subject-matter of the case involves initial recovery of 480 bottles of phensedyl and, subsequently, another 2400 bottles of phensedyl.

Learned advocate for the State submits that on the basis of statement of the son of the present petitioner, yaba tablets were also recovered and the investigation of the case is still in progress.

Having considered that the investigation of the case is still in progress and, *prima facie*, commercial quantity of contraband having been recovered, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Rejected.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1492 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
