- 1.** Present petition has been filed for expeditious disposal in S.T. 17 of 2025 arising out of Howrah Cyber Crime P.S. Case No.32 of 2021 dated 27th December, 2021 corresponding to G.R. No.7287 of 2021 under Sections 509/354D/120B/376 of the IPC and Sections 67/67A of the I.T. Act pending before the learned District and Sessions Judge, Howrah.
