Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

The petitioner states that a representation was submitted by the petitioner before the Collector on 13th December, 2002 stating the grounds of objection to the award.

The learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that no steps have been taken by the Collector to refer the matter for the determination of the Court.

Heard the learned Advocate for the State.

Since the petitioner has filed an application under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, without entering into the merits of the claim made in the said representation, WPA 26667 of 2025 stands disposed of by directing the Collector, North 24 Parganas, being the second respondent herein, to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 13th December, 2002, which is annexed as annexure P-2 at page 13 of the writ petition, in accordance with law and to pass a reasoned order.

The reasoned order shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of

receipt of the server copy of this order along with copy of the representation, which has been annexed as annexure P-2 at page 13 of this writ petition.
