An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Chanchal P.S. Case No.908 of 2025 dated 11.07.2025 under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 110, 303(2) and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The prime allegation is against the father of the petitioner who was arrested and thereafter granted bail.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail, relies on the statements of witnesses and the injury report and submits that the main allegations are against the father of the present petitioner.

Considering the materials available in the case diary and the alleged role ascribed to the present petitioner, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on the further conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation, shall meet the investigating officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
