An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Ranitala P.S. Case No.235 of 2024 dated 08.05.2024 under Sections 341/323/325/326/307/120B/506/34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The other co-accused were granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court while the petitioner's prayer was rejected. A charge-sheet has been submitted.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that there are four injured witnesses who have taken the names of the petitioner and others as the assailants. In the FIR, the petitioner's role has been specifically mentioned. As per the injury reports, one of the victims has suffered fracture injuries to the third and fourth ribs and other injuries were inflicted upon three other victims. The petitioner has been absconding for the last one and a half years.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
