Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that 105 bottles of Phensedyl were recovered from the
possession of the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody for
1 year and 3 months, investigation has been concluded and
charge sheet has been submitted; charges have been framed on
or about September, 2025 and dates have been fixed for
evidence. Petitioner prays for bail on any stringent conditions.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand,
submits that there are suppression of material facts as against
rejection of the order in CRM (NDPS) 355 of 2025.

Petitioner preferred an application for appeal before the
Hon'ble Supreme Court and the same has been dismissed in
Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No(s). 10971 of 2025.

Having considered the suppression pointed out by the learned advocate appearing for the State, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 1525 of 2025 is dismissed.
