Perused the case diary.

The prosecution case is that the present petitioner struck the head of a minor boy with a brick, which resulted in his death. Although the case was registered in November, 2024, he has approached this Court with a prayer for anticipatory bail in December, 2025.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
