Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested on 19.06.2024 and since then, he is in custody. Till date only two witnesses have been examined out of 11 witnesses proposed to be examined by the prosecution. On any stringent condition, petitioner prays for bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that two of the witnesses, who have been examined, have named and identified the petitioner.

Be that as it may, having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner and there is no possibility of trial being concluded very soon, I am inclined to release

the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Musaraf Mondal** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, 6th Court, Barasat.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of North 24-Parganas without the prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 1548 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
