In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Bauria P.S. Case No.177 of 2023 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 306/323/506/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

The prosecution case is that the petitioner is a friend of a girl with whom the victim had entered into a relationship. As per the petitioner, since the relationship did not work out, the boy committed suicide. After a delay of about two months, the FIR was lodged. Charge sheet has been submitted.

It will be for the Courts to finally decide whether there is any element of abetment of suicide in this case.

However, considering the materials available in the case diary, the alleged role ascribed to the present petitioner and the fact that charge sheet has already been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the petitioner shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence and shall surrender before the learned jurisdictional Court and pray for bail within four weeks from this date and shall attend the jurisdictional Court regularly.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
