The petitioners are confirmed Assistant
Teachers of two primary schools under DPSC,
Paschim Bardhaman, the respondent no. 5
herein, they are praying intra-district mutual
transfer.

The representation of the petitioners to the
said effect is pending consideration before the
Chairman of the said Council, the said
representation dated October 22, 2024 forms part
of the writ petition being Annexure-'P/4'.

The said Chairman is directed to consider
and dispose of the said representation
expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably
within a period of six weeks from the date of
communication of this order.

In the event, it is found that the learning process of the students of the respective schools of the petitioners would not be affected if the prayer of the petitioners is allowed, then the said Chairman of the said respondent no.5 Council shall take forward steps for mutual transfer of the petitioners.

WPA 27651 of 2024 is disposed with the above terms without any order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, the allegations contained in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied by the respondents.
