CRM (NDPS) 1617 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **NDPS Case No. 134 of 2024 arising out of Jiaganj PS Case No. 483 of 2024 dated 11.12.2024 u/s 20(b)(ii)(c)/25/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that from the house of the present petitioner allegedly there were recoveries of 49.2 kg of *ganja*, consequent to which, the petitioner was arrested and is in custody for about one year. Learned advocate also submits that other accused persons have been enlarged on bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that charge-sheet has also been submitted and the quantity seized do not call for any sympathy for the petitioner.

Having considered the quantum of seizure, at this stage, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Rejected.

However, the petitioner would renew his prayer for bail after the examination of the seizure list witnesses is over.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1617 of 2025 is **dismissed**.
