Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody for five and a half months and
he has been implicated on the basis of statement of the co-
accused from whom seizure has been effected. Petitioner prays
for bail on any stringent condition.

Learned advocate for the State submits that charge
sheet has been submitted and charge has been framed and
there are incriminating materials to the extent that on the
relevant date there were significant number of phone calls
between the petitioner and the principal accused from whom
seizures have been effected. There are antecedents of the
present petitioner also.

Having considered the stage of the case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Accordingly the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1557 of 2025 is dismissed.

Petitioner would renew his prayer for bail at the appropriate stage.
