An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Gangarampur P.S. Case No.11 of 2025 dated 05.01.2025 under Sections 21(c)/22(c)/27A/28/29 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that other than the statement of a co-accused there is no other material available against the present petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State relies on a document which is taken on record, and submits that there are criminal antecedents against the present petitioners involving offences under the NDPS Act. Besides, a proclamation and attachment has been issued on 18.08.2025 against the present petitioners.

Considering the materials available in the case diary, the criminal antecedent of the petitioners, the fact that a proclamation has been issued against the petitioners and the restrictions contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
