Petitioner contends that he is an Indian citizen and to
that effect have some documents in his custody and
unnecessarily he has been implicated in connection with
accusations under the Foreigners Act.

Learned advocate for the State submits that there are
overwhelming materials against the present petitioner.

In case the petitioner has documents in his custody, he
would produce the same before the learned Magistrate. Learned
Magistrate, if required, would consider testing the genuinity of
the same by directing the Investigating Officer of the case
concerned.

I do not find any fit case to be released on bail.

Consequently, CRM (M) 2562 of 2025 is dismissed.
