CRM (NDPS) 1629 of 2025

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Special Case No. 14 of 2022 arising out of Ketugram PS Case No. 70 of 2022 dated 19.02.2022 u/s 8(b)/15(c)/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was shown arrested in connection with the instant case and since then he is in custody for about four and half months.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the Case Diary wherefrom it reflects that there is no recovery from the possession of the present petitioner but the recovery was made from the one who is his relation (father) – who has already been granted bail. Learned advocate also added that the trial of the case is in progress.

Having considered the same and the fact that the petitioner is better placed than the other accused who has been granted bail, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Saidul Sk @ Sahidul Sk shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Judge, 3rd Special Court, Purba Bardhaman.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date of the trial so fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of Purba Bardhaman without prior permission of the learned Trial Court/Special Court

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 1629 of 2025 is **allowed.**
