1. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. The petitioner claims interest on delayed payment of terminal benefits. The petitioner superannuated from service of the WBTCCL on **December 31, 2020**. He received his terminal benefits of **Rs. 31,81,244/-** towards Provident Fund on **March 01, 2021** and **Rs. 10,94,404/-** towards leave encashment and gratuity on **February 25, 2021**.
3. The petitioner is entitled to interest for the period from **January 01, 2021** to **March 01, 2021** at the rate of 6 per cent per annum towards provident

fund and from ***January 01, 2021*** to ***February 25, 2021*** at the rate of 6 per cent per annum towards gratuity and leave encashment. Let the same be paid to the petitioner by the WBTCL within a period of one month from date.

4. In default of payment as directed above, the rate of interest shall stand increased to 9 per cent per annum.
5. The writ petition is disposed of.
6. There will be no order as to costs.
