In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Bhimpur Police Station case no. 205 of 2025 dated 22.07.2025 under Sections 103(1)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that he is in custody for 135 days and there was an altercation, scuffle and on being assaulted with a stick, the deceased who was in an inebriated condition succumbed.

Learned advocate for the State submits that the deceased was held by the present petitioner and other accused inflicted the fatal blow with the aid of a stick. Learned advocate further submits that date has been fixed for commitment of the case.

Be that as it may, considering the stage of the case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner being CRM (M) 2575 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

Petitioner is granted liberty to renew his prayer for bail after the stage of consideration of charges is over.
