Case No. 3320 of 2022).

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is similarly placed as Pravat Kumar Bera @ Khokon @ Pravat who has been granted bail in Special Leave Petition (CRL.) No. 8895/2025.

Learned advocate appearing for the State hands over the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and submits that it is difficult for the prosecution to distinguish between the role attributed by the present petitioner and the accused who has been granted bail.

Consequently, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Learned Sessions Court is directed to release the petitioner viz., **Sk Chand** on bail on such terms and conditions as it deems fit and proper to ensure the

appearance of the present petitioner in the future dates of trial.

The application for bail, being CRM (M) 2591 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
