1. Report forwarded by the Estate Manager, Estate Directorate & EX-officio Dy. Secy., Housing Department, dated 3rd December, 2024 is taken on record.
2. The petitioner seeks allotment of PRHE flats. The petitioner was given four options. As per the report of the Estate Manager, Estate Directorate & EX-officio Dy. Secy., Housing Department, the serial number of the petitioner's application is as follows:-

 - ii. 81st against 193, Andul Road LIG PRHE,
 - iii. 75th against ODRC LIG PRHE,
 - iv. 41st against Maniktala MIG PRHE
