CRM (M) 2598 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Nandigram Police Station case no. 267 of 2025 dated 30.04.2025 under Sections 137(2)/140(3)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita wherein Charge-sheet submitted under Sections 137(2)/140(3)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita read with Sections 6(1)/12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 125 days and there has been subsequent changes in the circumstances of the case, as such petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the Case Diary.

I have taken into account the statement under Section 183 of the BNSS.

Having considered that the evidence of the victim is yet to be recorded and charges have not been framed, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2598 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

Learned Special Court is directed to consider the charges as also complete the evidence of the victim by 28th of February, 2026.

Petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the aforesaid period is over.
