1. Petitioner renews the prayer for grant of bail on the ground of delay in disposal of the trial.
2. Petitioner stands implicated in murder. All prosecution witnesses were examined with two being recalled.
3. Trial is at the fag end.
4. In such circumstances, we request the learned trial Judge to endeavour to dispose of the trial as expeditiously as possible.

In doing so, learned trial Judge is requested not to grant any unnecessary adjournment to any of the parties.

5. Materials placed on record, the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner do not make it desirable to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.
6. Prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.
7. CRM(DB) 3966 of 2024 is **dismissed**.
