1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that the instant revisional application is not maintainable, since two separate proceedings have been challenged by filing in one revisional application. This is not permissible in the law.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits two FIRs have been lodged on the self-same incident as such, petitioners are facing jeopardizes with two complaints. However, he prays for withdrawal of the instant revisional application seeking liberty to file two separate revisional applications against two proceedings.
3. Prayer is allowed.
4. Accordingly, **CRR 4563 of 2023** is dismissed as withdrawn.
5. Consequently, the connected application, if any, is thus, disposed of.

6. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
7. Let the order be communicated to the Ld. Court below for information.
8. The petitioners are at liberty to file separate revisional applications against the two separate proceedings.
