The petitioners are confirmed Assistant Teachers of two different primary schools under DPSC, Purba Bardhaman, they are praying intra-district mutual transfer.

The representations of the petitioners to the said effect are pending consideration before the Chairman of the said Council, the respondent no.6 herein, the said representations, both dated November 12, 2024, forms part of the writ petition being Annexure-P/4,

The respondent no. 6 is directed to consider and dispose of the said representation expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of this order.

In the event, it is found that the learning process of the students of the respective schools of the petitioners would not be affected if the prayer of the petitioners is allowed, then the respondent no.6 shall take forward steps for mutual transfer of the petitioners expeditiously.

WPA 28147 of 2024 is thus disposed of without any order as to costs.

No affidavit since has been invited, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied by the respondents.
