The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of Title Suit No.441 of 2022, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 3rd Court at Krishnanagar.

It is submitted that service is not complete in respect of some of the defendants.

The prayer of the petitioner is innocuous. Neither party stands to lose if a proceeding is disposed of expeditiously. In fact, such expeditious disposal shall enure to the benefit of the parties. Hence, there is no requirement for service of prior notice upon the opposite parties.

The revisional application is disposed of with a request to the learned court to make a sincere endeavour to ensure that all the defendants are served within a reasonable time and then the court shall proceed to dispose of the said suit, preferably within a year from the next date fixed. Adequate

opportunity shall be granted to the parties to contest the same.

This court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the suit. The learned court shall proceed independently and in accordance with law.

A copy of the revisional application along with a server copy of this order be served upon the opposite parties and/or the learned advocate contesting the matter on behalf of the opposite parties in the learned trial court, within a week.

The revisional application is accordingly disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Parties are to act on the server copy of this order.
