1. The petitioners pray for expeditious disposal of Title Suit No. 633 of 2015, along with pending application which are pending before the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), 1st Court, Hooghly at Chinsurah.
2. The prayer of the petitioners is innocuous. Neither party stands to lose if a proceeding is disposed of expeditiously. In fact, such expeditious disposal shall enure to the benefit of the parties. Hence, there is no requirement for service of prior notice upon the opposite parties.
3. The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court to dispose of the application within three months from the next date fixed. Thereafter, the suit shall proceed expeditiously. Adequate opportunity shall be granted to the parties to contest the same.

4. This court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the application and the suit. The learned court shall proceed independently and in accordance with law.

5. A copy of the revisional application along with a server copy of this order be served upon the opposite parties and/or the learned advocate contesting the matter on behalf of the opposite parties in the learned court below, within a week.

6. The revisional application is accordingly disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

7. Parties are to act on the server copy of this order.
