In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Taherpur Police Station Case No. 13 of 2022 dated 10.01.2022 under Sections 448/325/326/307/392 adding Sections 412/413 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (G.R. Case No. 1156 of 2022).

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is similarly placed as the other accused person who has been granted bail in CRM(M) 2298 of 2025.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail, but is unable to dislodge the contention of the petitioner that petitioner is similarly situated as other accused who has been granted bail.

Having considered the materials appearing, I am of the view that further detention of the present petitioner in connection with the instant case is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Amit Biswas @ Amit Kumar Biswas** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of

whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Nadia without prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (M) 2736 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
