Affidavit-of-service filed by the petitioner be kept with the record.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner complains that the private respondents are disturbing the peaceful enjoyment of the property of the petitioner. It has been submitted that there is an injunction order passed by the Civil Court, in spite of the same there has been interference at the behest of the private respondents.

State has submitted a report. Report reflects that T.S. No. 3242 of 2010 is pending before the learned Civil Court. There is an issue relating to demarcation of the property.

Having considered that the dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents relates to demarcation of property, I am of the view that the police authorities will only interfere if there is any violation of law and order.

With the aforesaid observations WPA 28352 of 2024 is disposed of.
