The petitioner has approached this court at a stage when the investigation in relation to Haripal P.S. Case No. 456 of 2024 dated 30.07.2024 was pending.

During pendency of the writ petition, Charge-sheet No. 46 of 2025 dated 14.02.2025 has been submitted before the learned jurisdictional court with a prayer that the investigation officer has kept open the provision for filing Supplementary Affidavit after receipt of certain documents.

State has submitted a report prepared by the Officer-in-charge of Haripal Police Station.

Case Diary which has been produced be returned to the learned advocate for the State.

The petitioner is aggrieved by certain aspects of the investigation. Since the statutory provision(s) allows the petitioner being the defacto-complainant to file an application under Section 173(8) of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner would be at liberty to exhaust such remedy before the learned jurisdictional Court.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 28513 of 2024 is disposed of.
