In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 arising out of New Town Police Station case no. 168 of 2025 dated 25.08.2025 under Sections 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Sections 8/12/6 of the POCSO Act.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent of the charges and is in custody for four months, as such he may be released on bail on any stringent conditions.

Learned advocate for the State drawn the attention of the Court to the statement under Section 183 of BNSS.

I have taken into account the facts of the case and I am of the view that at this stage this is not a fit case for releasing the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 2714 of 2025 is **dismissed**.

Petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court and renew his prayer for bail after the evidence of the victim is recorded.

Learned Special Court is directed to complete the evidence of the victim at the earliest preferably within one and half months from the next date so fixed by the learned trial Court.
