CRM (NDPS) 1641 of 2025

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Hogolberia Police Station case no. 142 of 2025 dated 11.05.2025 under Sections 21(c)/25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated for alleged recovery of 800 bottles of phensedyl and is in custody for about seven months. As such, petitioner prays for bail on any stringent conditions.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that recovery was from the present petitioner and the other accused person was arrested on the basis of statements of co-accused.

I have taken into account the materials appearing against the petitioner and the quantum of seizure.

Having regard to the same, I direct that the learned trial Court will release the petitioner on bail after the stage of

framing of charges are overcome by the learned Special Court on such terms and conditions as the learned Special Court deems fit and proper for ensuring the appearance further before the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (NDPS) 1641 of 2025 is **disposed of**.
