Final order of assessment dated 19.11.2024 passed by the Assessing Officer, CESC Limited has been produced before this Court wherefrom it appears that a sum of Rs. 5,358/- (five thousand three hundred fifty eight only) is due and outstanding on account of electricity charges and Government duty payable for unauthorised use of electricity in respect of the subject meter.
