In re: An Application for **Bail** under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/section **483** of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Nakashipara** Police Station Case No. **382** of **2024** dated **19.04.2024** under Sections **323/325/326/307/302 & 34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Apparently, there were property disputes between the private parties. Apparently, the death occurred as a result of a free fight.

There is a delay in recording the statement under Section 161 of the Cr.P.C. which purports to implicate the petitioner.

The offending weapon was not recovered from the petitioner.

Considering such aspect of the period of detention of the petitioner, we grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the **Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Krishnagar, Nadia**, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

C.R.M.(DB) 4146 of 2024 is disposed of.
