Since the petitioner seeks expeditious disposal of G.R. case no. 4667 of 2022 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Baruipur, South 24 Parganas, the matter may be taken up for consideration without service of notice upon the opposite party. The opposite party shall not be prejudiced by an order directing expeditious disposal of the case.

It appears that cognizance of charge-sheet was taken by the learned Magistrate on 19th November, 2022.
