1. Petitioners pray for bail.
2. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that, statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and the eye-witness exonerates the petitioners.
3. The victim committed suicide.
4. Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the court to the post-mortem report and the materials in the case diary.
5. Post-mortem report suggests that the death was homicidal in nature due to manual strangulation. There is injury noted in the dead body.
6. Considering such post-mortem report, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. The prayer for bail is, thus, **rejected**.
8. CRM (DB) 4186 of 2024 is disposed of.
