This is an application for restoration of the writ
petition being WPA 29217 of 2024 by recalling order
dated 16th January, 2025.

The writ petition was dismissed for default on 16th
January, 2025.

Mr. Rupayan De, learned Advocate appearing for
the petitioner submits that on the date the matter was
called on, the clerk of the learned Advocate failed to
follow the list, resulting in non-appearance of the
learned Advocates and subsequent, dismissal of the writ
petition. He seeks for restoration of the writ petition
upon recalling of the order of dismissal.
