In re: An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Lalgola** Police Station Case No. **192** of **2019** dated **08.03.2019** under Sections **302/201/379/411** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

1. Petitioner is in custody in excess of 5 years 11 months.
2. Out of 19 prosecution witnesses 7 were examined at the trial.
3. There is hardly any possibility of the trial ending any time soon.
4. Considering the period of detention of the petitioner and on the principles of Article 21 of the Constitution of India, we grant bail to the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lalbagh, Murshidabad subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

6. In the event, the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without further reference to this Court.
7. The prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.
8. **CRM (DB) 4215 of 2024 is disposed of.**
